1 History


- 1. 1946. 5. College of Education, Medicine and Agriculture in Daegu were upgraded to National Colleges

1. Master's Programs and Integrated Master's & Doctoral Programs

- ① He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree
- ② He or she is not a citizen of Korea
- ③ His or her parents are not citizens of Korea
- * Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.
- B. Applicants of Korean origin must meet all of the following requirements:
 - ① He or she received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided

in Korea

- 2 He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Bachelor's degree
- * Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.

2. Doctoral Programs

A. International applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- 1) He or she holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree
- ② He or she is not a citizen of Korea
- ③ His or her parents are not citizens of Korea
- * Applicants who hold dual Korean citizenship are prohibited from applying. Citizenship status is determined as that which is held at the date of the application deadline.
- B. Applicants of Korean origin must meet all of the following requirements:
- ① He or she received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea

- ② English proficiency: A score report from a recognized English proficiency test such as: TOEFL 530(CBT 197, iBT 71), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 600 Points, TOEIC 700 or higher
- 3 Be a native English speaker

- ④ A confirmation letter of English or Korean proficiency issued by the department after the initial admission interview

- 2 Application Number: Automatically created after you complete the on-line application.
- B. Submission of Applications: All required documents should be submitted to the Office of International Affairs using one of the following methods:
- 1 In person
- ② By Post (either express or regular registered post-mail)
- A. Application Submission Period: October 28(Mon) to November 15(Fri) in 2019, by 18:00
- B. Where to Submit: The Office of International Affairs at Kyungpook National University (Global Plaza 6F, Room 608)
- C. How to Submit: Applicants should submit completed and printed application forms downloaded from the online application site, along with required documents ()~() in section 5 Required Documents. (Financial documents should be submitted after the department interview, except for applicants who can submit financial documents indicating funds of about USD18,000.
 - * All required documents must be submitted by the last day.

7 Scholarships(KINGS: KNU International Graduate Scholarships) and Benefits

1. Selection Period: Before the beginning of every semester up to 4th semester

2. Benefits: 100% or 50% of tuition fees waived

3. Number of Selected Applicants

A. New international students: up to 70 applicants based on 100% tuition payment

B. Enrolled international students: up to 210 applicants based on 100% tuition payment

8 Important Notes for Applicants

- 1. All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in another language should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- 2. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, your application will be canceled.
- 3. Any applicant submitting a certificate of expected graduation must submit the original copy or a notarized copy of the graduation certificate before beginning their first semester at Kyungpook National University.
- 4. The Office of International Affairs is not responsible for application cancellation due to incorrect contact information (such as address and phone number, etc.).
- 5. If an applicant's visa is not issued or is rejected, his or her application will be canceled.
- 6. Applicants receiving a scholarship from another institution are not required to submit a certificate of financial guarantee; however, they must submit a certificate/letter from the institution confirming that they will pay your tuition during your period of study at Kyungpook National University.
- 7. No submitted documents or application fees will be returned to the applicant. (Original copies of certificates of degree will be returned after the screening process is completed.)
